

# Privacy Policy

## What information we collect from you

There are two types of information we collect: information that allows us to identify specific individuals and information of a more generalized nature.

### Personal information

Whenever we ask for information that enables us to identify you it will be clear that we are doing so and in every case you will have a choice of how we use the information that is asked for. Information of this type will only be asked for on those parts of our web site that allows transactions to be performed, in contrast to those parts of our web site that are merely informational in their function.

Information of this type will also be collected when you contact us directly by email for any reason or if you specifically request that we send you information.

### Anonymised information

This website uses cookies to help you in your interactions with the site. No personally identifiable data is collected. This type of information helps us to enhance the web site and improve its navigability. It also helps us to improve the quality of the online services and information you can access. In order to facilitate this, we use cookies to identify specific information about your visits to the site.

This site uses AWStats <http://awstats.sourceforge.net> to allow us to track how popular our site is and to record visitor trends over time. AWstats uses a cookie to help track which pages are accessed. The cookie contains no personally-identifiable information, but it does use your computer's IP address to determine where in the world you are accessing the site from, and to track your page visits within the site.

From time to time, we may embed external content from third-party websites (e.g. Facebook, YouTube) within our web site. These websites may utilise cookies and the Privacy Policy that will apply to such third-party content will be that published on the website of that third-party content provider.

### Links to non District 105-I Lions websites

The District 105-I Lions website may provide links to third-party websites for your convenience and information. If you access those links, you will leave the District 105-I website. Lions District 105-I do not control those sites or their privacy practices, which may differ from the Lions District 105-I website. We do not endorse or make any representations about third-party

websites. The personal data you choose to give to unrelated third parties is not covered by the Lions District 105-I Privacy Policy. We encourage you to review the privacy policy of any organisation before submitting your personal information.

## Children's Privacy

Lions District 105-I are committed to protecting the privacy needs of children and we encourage parents and guardians to take an active role in their children's online activities and interests.

## Cookies

A "cookie" is a small data file transferred by a website to your computer hard drive. Accepting the session cookie used on our site does not give us access to your personal information. Cookies are typically classified as either "session" cookies or "permanent" cookies.

- **"Session" cookies** do not stay on your computer after you leave our website or close your browser. The aggregate information collected permits us to analyse traffic patterns on our site. This can enable us over time to provide a better experience on our site by improving content or personalization and making our site easier to use.
- **"Permanent" cookies** are those that remain on your computer. Lions District 105-I do not utilise permanent cookies on this web site.

Most browsers automatically accept cookies by default, but you can usually refuse cookies or selectively accept certain cookies by adjusting the preferences in your browser. If you turn off cookies, there may be some features of our site that will not be available to you and some web pages may not display properly.
